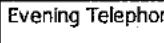

The same thing may happen at a steady rate of speed. We tried to get this fixed with the recall, but because we ordered the truck from [REDACTED] there is no record in the 'system' of this VIN number

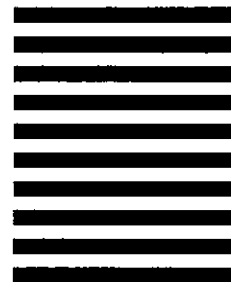
