RE: Recall Campaign No. 14V-176: VANOS Assembly Bolts

My 2011 BMW 128i received a recall notice from NHTSA back in June 2014. I then received a recall notice from BMW North America in June 2014. My BMW dealer, BMW of Ontario, CA informed me that my car is indeed on the recall list but they have no parts and no direction on how to proceed from BMW NA. I contacted BMW NA by phone as was told to just drive the car and if it fails have it towed to the nearest dealer.

Please help my AAA towing is only good for 100 miles and I often exceed that. For example, I drive that car to Nevada periodically on highway 15 to highway 127N where there is no cellphone coverage for a bit over 53 miles through the desert.

I am scared to drive this BMW 128i very far from home now.

Please advise on what I should do?

Dear BMW Owner/Lessee:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

BMW AG has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain Model Year 2010-12 BMW 1 Series, 3 Series, 5 Series, 5 Series Gran Turismo, 6 Series, X3 SAV, X5 SAV, X6 SAV and Z4 models. Our records indicate that you are the owner or lessee of an affected vehicle.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

Please note that at the present time we do not yet have sufficient parts to conduct this recall; however, we will notify you as soon as parts become available. At that time, you should make an appointment with your authorized BMW center in order to have this recall performed on your vehicle.

DESCRIPTION OF PROBLEM

This recall involves the housing bolts of the variable camshaft timing (VANOS) adjustment unit. The bolts may possibly loosen over time and, under certain circumstances, may break. As a result, the reduced engine power "safe mode" may be activated. In some cases the engine cannot be started after switching off and less frequently the engine could stall which could lead to a crash.

PRECAUTIONS FOR YOUR SAFETY

1. If you notice a distinct change in engine running condition and hear increased engine noise, the vehicle may be experiencing this condition. If this occurs, you should immediately contact the nearest authorized BMW center to arrange for inspection and service.
2. If you notice a Check Engine (or Service Engine Soon) warning light and a Check Control message that the reduced engine power "safe mode" is activated either immediately or at startup of the next driving cycle, the vehicle may be experiencing this condition. If this occurs, you should immediately contact the nearest authorized BMW center to arrange for inspection and service.

3. If the engine stalls, you should carefully move away from traffic and pull over to a safe location as soon as possible and stop the vehicle. You should contact BMW Roadside Assistance at 1-800-332-4269 to have your vehicle brought to the nearest authorized BMW center. You should not continue to drive the vehicle.
4. If you are not the only driver of this vehicle, please advise all other drivers and passengers of this important information.

DESCRIPTION OF REPAIR

The VANOS attachment bolts will be replaced. The actual repair will require approximately four hours; however, additional time may be required depending on the BMW center's schedule. This work will be performed free of charge by your authorized BMW center.

If you are no longer the owner of this vehicle, we would appreciate your furnishing us with the name and address of the new owner, using the enclosed postage-paid card. If you are the lessor of this vehicle, Federal Regulations require you to forward this notice to your lessee with ten days.

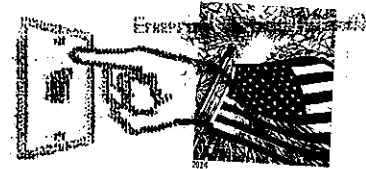
