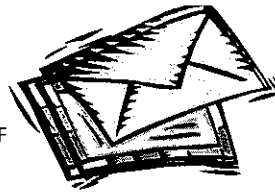

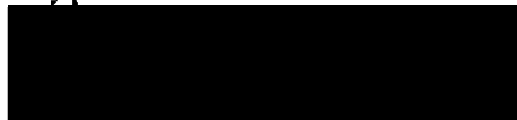

NHTSA had recalled 2.8 Million Hondas

Included was my model year, CIVIC 2004.
However, my car wasn't included in the recall
because the recall was geographically limited
to warm states.

Then, on Wednesday, October 22nd, the NHTSA
expanded the recall to 5 Million Hondas
