Please let me know if my vehicle (identified above) has one of the defective airbags designed by Takata. I understand that my car is not currently on the recall list; however, I also understand that recalls are being issued in stages, not all at once.

At present I feel I cannot drive my car as Honda has not informed me whether or not I have one of the potentially defective airbags from Takata. Even if I cannot immediately obtain a replacement airbag, I need and have a right to this information, and I look forward to receiving it as soon as possible.

If Honda does not inform me promptly that my car has one of the defective airbags, I will take that to mean that it does not and that I may continue driving the car without fear of harm from the airbag.
