I have a 2005 Camry xle with 95 thousand miles. While driving I noticed a rubber smell 5miles from home. At home I opened my hood and noticed the belt jumped and break the belt tensioner pulley bolt. Now it is costing about \$2000 to replace a \$2 bolt. Other option is buy a new head and pay \$1500. Either way the engine has to come out to replace the bolt. Interesting to realize that no amount of room exist to remove the broken bolt. Is the drive belt pull ya recall. I put my repairs on hold at precision tune.
