

Dear Sir or Madam,

I am writing to inform you of a hazard involving the design of the window and door posts in my 2013 Mazda 3, four door sedan. The posts are wider in this car, than any car I have owned before, and cause a serious blind spot.

I have noticed this particularly at a stop intersection. I stop at the intersection threshold line, then slowly roll forward in order to get a better view, and on several occasions my roll is synchronized with the movement of vehicles approaching from the right. At these times the approaching vehicle is completely blocked from my view, by the window post.

Also when backing, the view to the right is blocked by door post and front passenger seat headrest. Now, I always try to lean forward and backward to look around these posts before proceeding.

I know nothing can be done about my car at this point, but I think people should be warned about this hazard and future designs should eliminate this problem.
