They also turn on if the wipers make a few strokes, because it is probably raining.

All vehicles should be wired in this safety dictated method.

Also, the parking lights should not turn on if the vehicle is in gear.

They are *parking* lights!


It may be safe to say that these suggestions would be very cheap to implement,

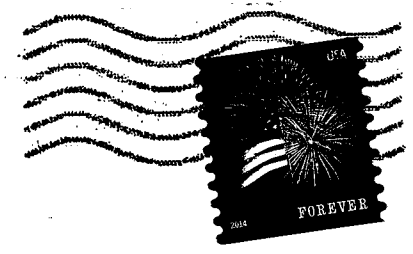
