I did contact Chrysler, who had no explanation as to why replacement parts would not be made available. The only option was to disconnect switch. I believe Chrysler and my dealer have no intention of repairing this defective part.

It was also suggested that if the switch is disconnected, it would be easier for the dealer to receive the replacement part, which I find ridiculous if there is a current recall.

I have been on a waiting list at a different dealer 2 hours away for months now

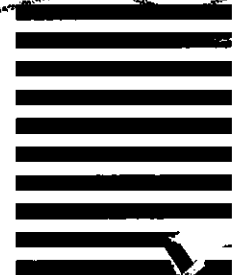

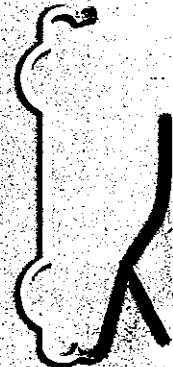
