RV was purchased from RV sales around 10/15/2013 in PA, Caller purchased bunk beds for her RV then discovered when she was allowing her ■ yr old climb into the top bunk that it had no guard rails.

She requested that she be allowed to purchase guard rails for this bunk bed, she was advised to contact the manufacturer.

She contacted the manufacturer and they replied that she should speak with the dealer.

The manufacturer advised the caller that they had never manufactured guard rails with their bunk-beds because there was no demand.

The caller sent CPSC advisement that guard rails are required for any bed 30 inches from the floor.

There are no injuries to report

The consumer has purchased a net type guardrail with a T type attachment that goes under the mattress and is held only by her child's weight. She is asking for help and guidance with this situation before children are injured.
