Subject: Nissan Altima 2008 melting dashboard

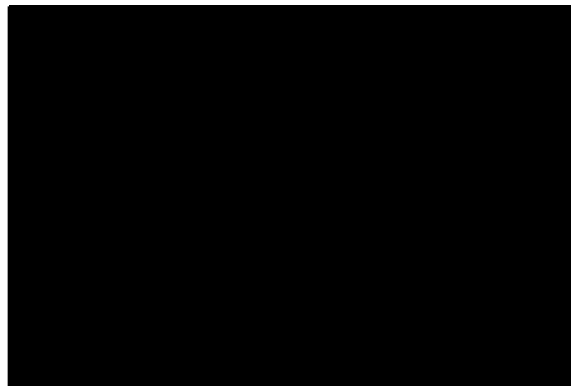

Since my first contact by phone, my dashboard has melted at an alarming rate and continues to do so. As a result, when driving into direct sunlight 85% of the driver's side of the windshield is covered with a thin bubbly film giving me only 50% visibility. Cars are hazy, pedestrians and cyclists are blurry, and overhead road signs are impossible to read. Both car occupants and the public are in danger. It would be unconscionable to wait for fatalities to issue a recall. Nissan is stalling in the pending class action law suit and with the summer upon us, the situation will get much worse.

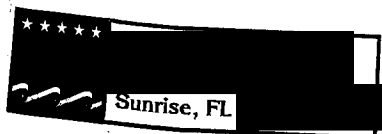
I implore you to issue a recall.
