
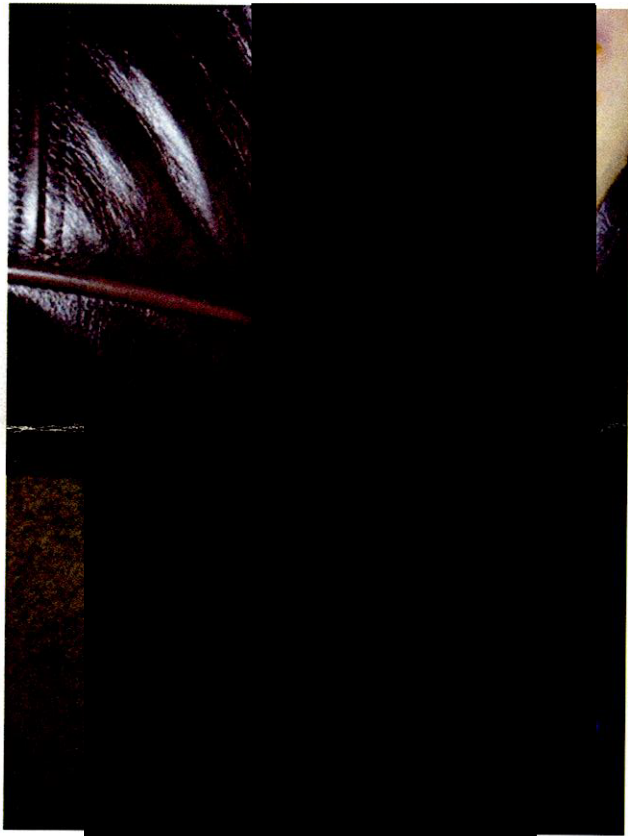

TL* THE CONTACT OWNS A 2013 CHRYSLER TOWN AND COUNTRY. WHILE THE VEHICLE WAS IN THE PARK POSITION, THE VEHICLE INDEPENDENTLY ROLLED AND KNOCKED THE CONTACT TO THE FLOOR. THE FRONT DRIVER SIDE TIRE RAN OVER THE CONTACT'S LEFT LEG AND CONTINUED TO ROLL DOWN A HILL UNTIL IT STOPPED AT THE BOTTOM OF AN EMBANKMENT. THE CONTACT SUSTAINED TISSUE AND NERVE DAMAGE ON HER LEFT LEG, TWO TORN ROTATOR CUFFS ON HER LEFT SHOULDER, AND <del>SOME</del> BRUISING ON THE ENTIRE LEFT SIDE OF HER TORSO THAT REQUIRED MEDICAL ATTENTION. A POLICE REPORT WAS FILED. THE MANUFACTURER WAS NOT NOTIFIED OF THE FAILURE. THE VEHICLE WAS TAKEN TO AN INDEPENDENT MECHANIC WHERE THE DOOR AND THE SUB SEAT STOWING AREA WERE REPAIRED. THE CAUSE OF THE FAILURE WAS UNKNOWN. THE FAILURE MILEAGE WAS 30,484.

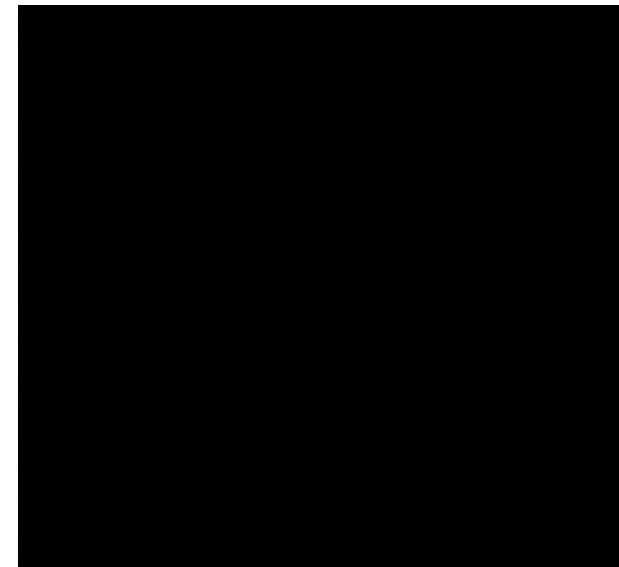
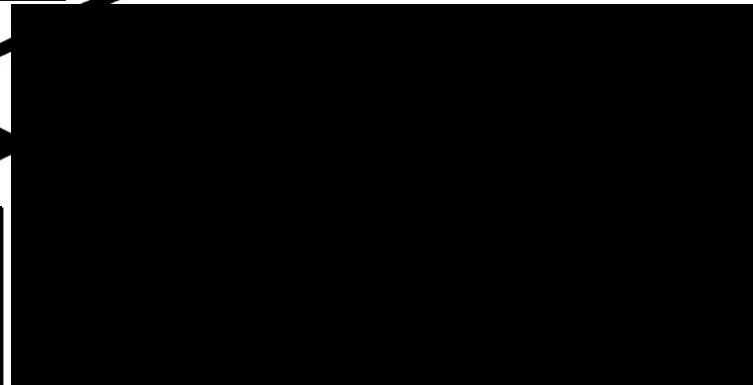
