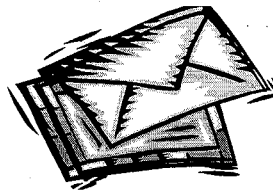

As per your instructions I am sending you further information concerning my complaint about the faulty airbags in the two vehicles that I own.

The first vehicle is a 2008 Ford Mustang GT . The Vin number is 1zvht82h685 [REDACTED]. I recieved the notice from the Ford Motor Company in July of this year about the defective airbag. I called my local dearlership , Ford Motor Company and the National Transportation Board for further clarification on when I could expect this defect to be rectify and was told that they did not know and that there would be some notification in the mail "soon".

The second vehicle is a 2004 325 series BMW. The Vin number is wbad33464j [REDACTED]. This vehicle, I recieved the notice from BMW back in August of 2014 of the defective airbag and was told by BMW that they would install a new airbag once they recieved the replacement parts from the Takata Corporation in Mexico. I am still waiting.
