We noticed that when my 90 pound son sat in the front passenger seat, the 'passenger airbag deactivated' light would come on and stay on. I started paying attention to it and noticed it also would stay on for me, but not every time, and I am 270 pounds. We reported this to the local Nissan Dealer in Peoria, IL and they told us they checked it and everything came back fine... was told the new sensors in the seat were very sensitive to seating location of the passenger, and to 'move around' a bit to activate the passenger air bag system. That did not work. We still have the problem to this day.
