TL* THE CONTACT OWNS A 2005 NISSAN TITAN. WHILE DRIVING 20 MPH, THE VEHICLE LOST POWER AND RESTARTED AFTER NUMEROUS ATTEMPTS. THE CONTACT STATED THAT THE FUEL GAUGE WAS NOT REGISTERING. THERE WERE NO WARNING INDICATORS ILLUMINATED. THE VEHICLE WAS NOT DIAGNOSED OR REPAIRED. THE VIN WAS NOT INCLUDED IN NHTSA CAMPAIGN NUMBER: 10V074000 (FUEL SYSTEM). THE MANUFACTURER WAS NOT MADE AWARE OF THE FAILURE. THE FAILURE MILEAGE WAS UNKNOWN. *Guage read 1/4 tank.*

I had to walk to dollar store, buy gas can \$12 and walk to gas station, then back to pickup. Vehicle started only after I added gas, when vehicle ran out of gas, no warning light or buzzer, guage read 1/4 tank. I was in school zone, lost steering power and brake, power, unable to turn or brake, had to coast to a stop.
