I purchased a 2005 Chevrolet Cobalt brand new. I currently still own the vehicle. From the moment I purchased the vehicle, I've had electrical issues. I had issues with the clutch & my cruise control not working upon purchasing the vehicle. I was sent to the shop 2-3 times under warranty to try & fix the electrical problems of the cruise control & clutch.

In July 2015, I was in heavy traffic, at a busy intersection, & I had the power to my engine completely stop working. I was almost HIT & KILLED. My car lit up with "ENG PWR REDUCED" when this happened. It has been doing this off & on since July. It will completely reduce all engine power when it does this & sometimes shut the car down while it's driving. I have contacted GM regarding this issue. They contacted me regarding this on 8-12-2015. I have had no resolve on this matter & my car is still having the same issue. I was told by GM to write a complaint to the "National Highway Traffic & Safety Administration" headquarters.

The recall for the ignition switch was done the 1st of August 2015, & the car is still not working properly.

Upon searching the internet, I am not the only owner of a Cobalt with that issue. There are numerous other owners with the same exact "life threatening" issues & they are also scared for their lives.

This needs to be addressed & **RECALLED IMMEDIATELY!!!**
