since February, 2014. It has license plates on
it, however the registration has lapsed, and the
car is no longer insured. The North Plainfield

property and no one complains, it's alright.
I consider this a kindness and a concession
on their part. They will come if someone complains.

A review of my materials will reveal the
loss of time, the expense and the suffering
related to this 2002 Echo Toyota. I can send

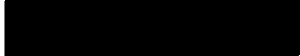
