THE FAILURE RECURRED ON SEVERAL OCCASIONS. THE VEHICLE WAS TAKEN BACK TO THE DEALER AND WAS DIAGNOSED THAT SQUIB NUMBER ONE CIRCUIT HAD SHORTED AND THERE WAS A POSSIBLE PINCHED WIRE ON THE DRIVERS SIDE AIR BAG WIRING.
