TL* THE CONTACT OWNS A 2005 CHEVROLET SSR. WHILE THE VEHICLE WAS PARKED, IT FAILED TO TURN OFF WITHOUT WARNING AFTER NUMEROUS ATTEMPTS. THE VEHICLE WAS NOT DIAGNOSED NOR REPAIRED. THE MANUFACTURER WAS NOT NOTIFIED OF THE FAILURE. THE VIN WAS UNKNOWN. THE FAILURE MILEAGE WAS 58,000. The report that the agent entered is very erroneous. I did give her the VIN, I told her I called the dealer, and the manufacturer- With no solution. I told her that I have owned three Chevy 2005 SSR's. All three have exhibited ignition switches that 1) the engine would not turn off when the key was removed, 2) the radio would not shut off when the key was removed, 3) the alarm buzzer would not stop buzzing when the key was removed. To turn off engine, I had to touch the brake & open & close the car door... Sometimes several times. Same thing to turn off the radio. To stop the warning buzzer I had to many times insert the key, wiggle it, and then remove it. THIS IS THE SAME MODEL YEARS OF GM VEHICLES THAT WERE RECALLED BY THE MILLIONS. THIS MODEL GOT MISSED.
