This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

General Motors has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2001 model year Pontiac Grand Prix vehicles equipped with a 3.8L V6 engine. As a result, GM is conducting a safety recall. We apologize for this inconvenience. However, we are concerned about your safety and continued satisfaction with our products.

## IMPORTANT

- Your vehicle is involved in GM safety recall 15757.
- Parts to repair your vehicle are not currently available.
- Previously, your vehicle was repaired under a safety recall for this condition. The remedy procedure performed on your vehicle may not be sufficient to prevent subsequent engine compartment fires relating to this condition. Your vehicle will require further repairs to remedy the condition.
- **Until you have had your vehicle repaired it is recommended that the vehicle be parked outside and not in a garage or other structure.**

**Why is your vehicle being recalled?**

Drops of engine oil may be deposited on the exhaust manifold through hard braking. This condition could cause an engine compartment fire.

**What will we do?**

**Parts to repair your vehicle are not currently available**, but when parts are available, your General Motors dealer will replace your engine's front valve cover and front-valve-cover gasket with new parts of an improved design. Your engine's plastic "beauty" cover and plastic oil-fill-tube extension will be removed, if they haven't been already. This service will be performed for you at **no charge**.

When parts are available, we will send you another letter asking you to take your vehicle to your General Motors dealer to have your vehicle serviced. If you have already paid for repairs for this condition, a reimbursement request form will be included with the next letter.



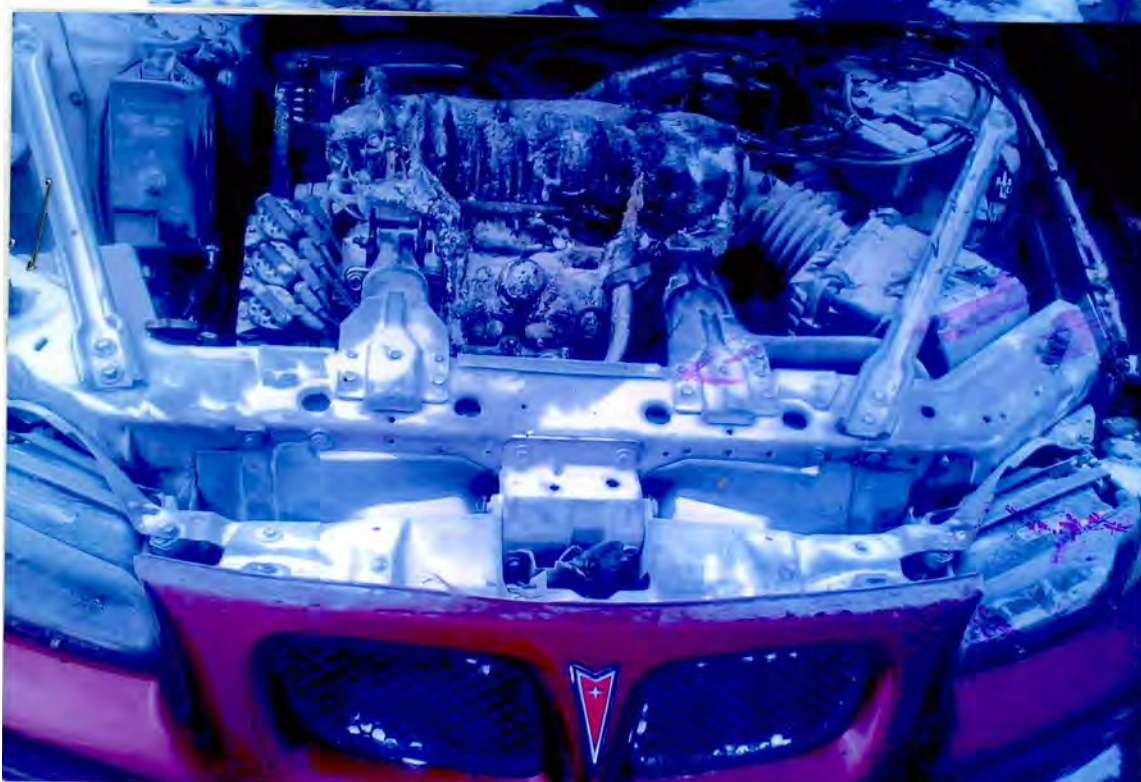

Official recalls have been issued for the 2001 Pontiac Grand Prix by the NHTSA. The complete details of all recalls are listed below, along with what they cover and the recommended solutions.

**1. 2001 Pontiac Grand Prix EXTERIOR LIGHTING: HEADLIGHTS NHTSA Campaign #09E025000**

- **Date Announced:** MAY 11, 2009
- **Vehicles Affected:** 42,540

**Summary:** Dope, Inc. Is recalling 42,540 combination corner and bumper lamp assemblies of various part numbers sold for use as aftermarket equipment for various passenger vehicles. These headlamps fail to conform to the requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard no. 108, "lamps, reflective devices, and associated equipment." These lamps do not contain the required amber side reflectors.

**Consequence:** Decreased lighting visibility may result in a vehicle crash.

**Actions:** Dope, Inc. Will notify owners and offer a full refund for the noncompliant combination lamps. The safety recall began on July 28, 2009. Owners may contact dope, Inc. At 1-626-272-1798. **2. 2001 Pontiac Grand Prix ENGINE AND ENGINE COOLING NHTSA Campaign #09V116000**

- **Date Announced:** APRIL 08, 2009
- **Vehicles Affected:** 1,497,516



**Summary:** General Motors is recalling 1,497,516 MY 1997-2003 Buick regal, MY 1998-2003 Chevrolet lumina, Monte Carlo and Impala, MY 1998-1999 Oldsmobile intrigue, MY 1997-2003 Pontiac Grand Prix vehicles equipped with a 3.8L V6 naturally aspirated engine. Some of these vehicles have a condition in which drops of engine oil may be deposited on the exhaust manifold through hard braking.

**Consequence:** If the manifold is hot enough and the oil runs below the heat shield, it may ignite into a small flame and may spread to the plastic spark plug wire channel and beyond increasing the risk of an engine compartment fire.

**Actions:** Dealers will remove the spark plug wire retention channel at the front of engine and install two new spark plug wire retainers free of charge. The recall is expected to begin during May 2009. ### 3. 2001 Pontiac Grand Prix EXTERIOR LIGHTING NHTSA Campaign #09E012000

- **Date Announced:** APRIL 07, 2009
- **Vehicles Affected:** 16,270

**Summary:** Sabersport is recalling 16,270 combination corner and bumper lamp assemblies of various part numbers sold for use as aftermarket equipment for various passenger vehicles. These headlamps fail to conform to the requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard no. 108, "lamps, reflective devices, and associated equipment." These lamps do not contain the required amber side reflectors.

**Consequence:** Decreased lighting visibility may result in a vehicle crash.

**Actions:** Sabersport will notify owners and offer a full refund for the noncompliant combination lamps. The safety recall began on May 11, 2009. Owners may contact sabersport at 1-909-598-7589. ### 4. 2001 Pontiac Grand Prix STEERING NHTSA Campaign #09E005000

- **Date Announced:** FEBRUARY 17, 2009
- **Vehicles Affected:** 979

**Summary:** Dorman is recalling 979 steering knuckles, dorman P/nos. 697-902 and 697-903, sold under dorman's "oe solutions<sup>™</sup>" brand name, and Napa P/nos. 7-8502 and 7-8503 which were sold for replacement use on the various vehicles listed above. A potential material or design defect could result in the steering knuckle breaking in the hub area.

**Consequence:** A broken steering knuckle could result in loss of steering control and a possible crash without warning.

**Actions:** Dorman will notify owners and replace the defective steering knuckles free of charge and reimburse the repair facility or owner for labor. The recall began on February 23, 2009. ### 5. 2001 Pontiac Grand Prix ENGINE AND ENGINE COOLING NHTSA Campaign #08V118000

- **Date Announced:** MARCH 12, 2008
- **Vehicles Affected:** 207,542

**Summary:** GM is recalling 207,542 MY 1997-2003 Buick regal and Pontiac Grand Prix vehicles equipped with a 3.8L supercharged V-6 engine. These vehicles have higher front rocker cover gasket temperatures, creating the potential for earlier degradation of the front rocker cover gasket and eventual oil seepage.

**Consequence:** Certain underhood fires may be caused by drops of engine oil, from seepage or spillage, being deposited on the exhaust manifold through hard braking. If the manifold is hot enough and the oil runs below the heat shield, it may ignite into a small flame and, in some instances, the fire may spread to the plastic spark plug wire channel and beyond.

**Actions:** Dealers will install a new front (left) rocker cover gasket with an improved design from the original gasket and replace the spark plug wire channel with new retainers. Due to parts availability, owner notification letters will be mailed in two phases. The customer letters for the 1997-2000 model year vehicles will be mailed on April 28, 2008. GM will advise as to when the owner letters for the 2001-2003 model year vehicles will be mailed. Until sufficient parts become available, GM strongly recommends that owners observe the following important precautions (1) they strongly recommend that owners do not park their vehicle in a garage, car port, or other structure; (2) if owners notice a burning odor, they should have their dealer inspect the vehicle. The dealer will inspect the vehicle without charge; (3) use premium fuel (91 octane or higher) in the vehicle as recommended in the vehicle's owner manual. 6. **2001 Pontiac Grand Prix FUEL SYSTEM, OTHER:STORAGE:TANK ASSEMBLY:PRESSURE RELIEF DEVICES NHTSA Campaign #07E021000**

- **Date Announced:** MARCH 12, 2007
- **Vehicles Affected:** 742

**Summary:** Certain delphi fuel pressure regulators, P/nos. FP10020-11B1, FP10026-11B1, and FP10027-11B1, sold after January 9, 2007, as aftermarket equipment for various passenger vehicles listed above. The universal pressure regulators (upr) were produced without an O'ring and retainer.

**Consequence:** Fuel may leak, possibly resulting in a fire.

**Actions:** Delphi will notify owners and replace the upr free of charge. The recall began on April 23, 2007. Owners can contact delphi at 877-411-8770. For detailed information & supporting documents, see the [official NHTSA page concerning recall #07E021000](#) »

7. **2001 Pontiac Grand Prix AIR BAGS:FRONTAL NHTSA Campaign #02V329000**

- **Date Announced:** DECEMBER 09, 2002
- **Vehicles Affected:** 272

**Summary:** On certain passenger, sport utility vehicles and mini vans, some of these vehicles have a passenger air bag that was manufactured without a check valve pin. An air bag without the check valve pin could produce increased pressure at the onset of the air bag deployment and reduced pressure afterward.

**Consequence:** This could increase the severity of injury to a person who was not properly restrained and who was close to the passenger air bag at the time of deployment. It could also reduce the ability of the air bag to protect a restrained front seat passenger.

**Actions:** Dealers will inspect and, if necessary, replace the passenger air bag. Owner notification began December 16, 2002. Owners who take their vehicles to an authorized dealer on an agreed upon service date and do not receive the free remedy within a reasonable time should contact Chevrolet at 1-800-222-1020, Pontiac at 1-800-762-2737, Oldsmobile at 1-800-442-6537, or Saturn at 1-800-553-6000, prompt #3. 8. **2001 Pontiac Grand Prix AIR BAGS:FRONTAL NHTSA Campaign #01V026000**

- **Date Announced:** FEBRUARY 01, 2001
- **Vehicles Affected:** 38

**Summary:** Vehicle description: Passenger, sport utility vehicles and minivans. The passenger air bag inflator modules were built without the correct amount of generant, which produces the gas that fills the air bag. Some were built with a double load of generant and some were built without generant.

**Consequence:** In the event of a crash that would trigger a passenger air bag deployment, a double load of generant can cause the inflator module to explode. If the air bag module explodes, metal and plastic debris could cause severe injury to vehicle occupant. A module with no generant would not inflate the air bag, and the occupants could receive more severe injuries.

**Actions:** Dealers will replace the passenger air bag module. Telephone calls were made to owners on January 29, 2001. Follow up owner mailing began on April 17, 2001. Owners who take their vehicles to an authorized dealer on an agreed upon service date and do not receive the free remedy within a reasonable time should contact Chevrolet at 1-800-222-1020, Pontiac at 1-800-762-2737, or Saturn at 1-800-553-6000. #### 9. 2001 Pontiac Grand Prix SEAT BELTS NHTSA Campaign #00V228003

- **Date Announced:** AUGUST 07, 2000
- **Vehicles Affected:** 156,305

**Summary:** Vehicle description: Passenger vehicles, light duty trucks, sport utility vehicles, and mini vans equipped with TRW seat belt buckle assemblies. The buckle base of these seat belt assemblies were not properly heat treated and therefore do not pass the load bearing requirement of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard no. 209, "seat belt assemblies."

**Consequence:** In the event of a vehicle crash, the occupant may not be properly restrained.

If this occurs, there could be a fire in your vehicle and nearby property.

What will we do?

Your Pontiac dealer will replace the spark plug wire channel with new spark plug wire retainers. This service will be performed for you at **no charge**. Because of service scheduling requirements, it is likely that your dealer will need your vehicle longer than the actual service correction time of approximately 15 minutes.

There are two very important precautions you should take before your vehicle is serviced:
