- I received an Important Safety Recall Letter from Jeffrey M. Boyer, Vice President of Global Vehicle Safety. He recommends that my Pontiac Grand Prix be parked outside of a garage because the vehicle may catch on fire unless the car is serviced. His contact information was not on the Important Safety Recall Letter.
- The parts are not available to service my vehicle.
- I have to park my car in a garage. I am concerned of the fire risk.
- I have not found a willing buyer of the vehicle because of the safety recall.
- Please tell me how to be reimbursed for my vehicle through GM for my 2002 Pontiac Grand Prix.
- I would like GM to buy my vehicle from me for \$3,400, the value of the vehicle.

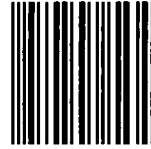

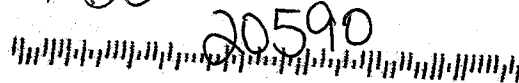
