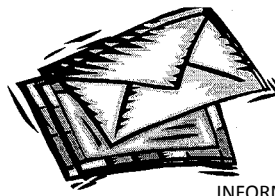

Well over a year ago, a potentially life threatening defect was identified in the airbags in many automobiles. My daughter's 2008 Ford Mustang was identified as one of the cars involved. On May 27, 2015, Ford issued a recall for the "Driver Airbag Inflator Replacement", NHTSA Recall Number 15V319, Ford Recall Number 15S21. On November 12, 2015, I contacted both Ford motor company and Koons-Sterling Ford about the recall, since my daughter had heard nothing more about it. They told me that the parts were still not available and might not be until the second quarter of 2016. I expressed my concern with the long delay in correcting this potentially life threatening defect. They told me we would hear something as soon as parts were available. I have heard nothing since then and would greatly appreciate any help you can give me to get Ford to correct the defect in my daughter's car as soon as possible. Ford seems to be able to install safe airbags in new cars they want to sell, but doesn't seem to be taking much of an interest in correcting that serious defect in cars they previously sold. Thank you for your help.
