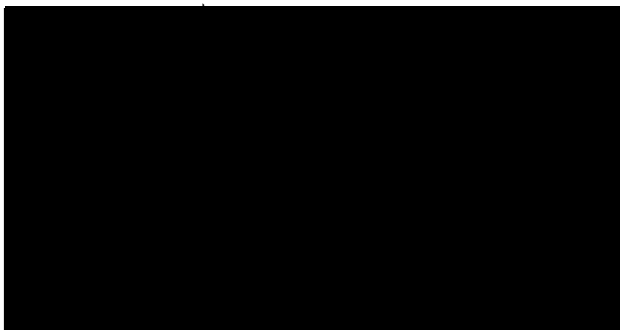

I would like to know what is considered reasonable time allowed for this type of recall?
