TL\* THE CONTACT OWNS A 2015 (NA) PRIME TIME 3210 (NA) FIFTH WHEEL TRAILER. WHILE DRIVING 55 MPH, THE CONTACT NOTICED THAT THE TIRES WERE WORN OUT AT 12,000 MILES. THE VEHICLE WAS TAKEN TO AN INDEPENDENT MECHANIC WHERE IT WAS DIAGNOSED THAT THE AXLES WERE OUT OF ALIGNMENT AND THE WHEELS WERE NOT PARALLEL TO THE FRAME AND NEEDED TO BE REALIGNED. THE VEHICLE WAS NOT REPAIRED. THE MANUFACTURER WAS MADE AWARE OF THE FAILURE. THE APPROXIMATE FAILURE MILEAGE WAS 12,000.

The Manufacturer denied there was a problem until I ~~called~~ told them I was going to let them deal with my attorney. Then they scheduled me a second appointment with a different Dealer for inspection. They confirmed the alignment of the axles were a real problem. Prime Time agreed to pay for independent mechanic repairs. However they are currently refusing to pay for replacement tires.

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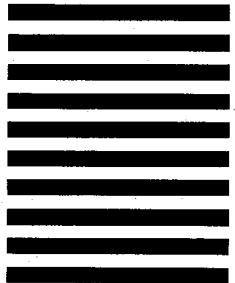
