On 4 August 2016 I purchased A Rockwood
8280 WS Forest River 5th Wheel.

I thought, believed, I was buying A
"NEW" unit, but now? I did not
begin loading it till Eight weeks later. I
realized it had not been Detailed, given
Tech Orientation or Purge And h.p. Tanks
filled. I spent A month in Arizona
Where it was pointed out the under belly
Frame, Rear level Jacks were Extremely
rusty. The REAR section of the bottom
cover was sagging down.

I spent one month, then stopped At
Camping World, Anthony, Texas for service.
They checked Air Conditioner, Noted
damage to Right Front Rain Gutter. Their
Setup/Delivery Rep. Asked if he could use
My R.V. to train A NEW Employee. They seemed
AMAZED AND recorded what they SAID. I
Asked if they could get the Windows "opened."
The trainer outside and trainee inside working
together broke the windows loose from the side.
I Asked if they could Also get the outside
Vent CAP to the stove open. The TWO
working together got it open breaking it.
It was later Fixed, Warranty.

A month and three weeks later I drove home to Dover, MN. for Xmas. I took the R.V. Dealer Campsite, Cresco, IA. for Warranty Work and to be winterized till Spring. It was stored till Spring and kept there when I am not using it.

After making TEN payments I called Bank of the West OMAHA Nebraska. I explained believing I did not get my Monies Worth. Also the Bank had not either in financing the loan,

The process of Resolution NOTED, on page 12, TRILER Life got my attention. This process is similar to the Auto Lemon Law. I agreed to make a Effort. "Soon" it was evident this was not going to happen. "Both" the Bank and Camping World joined to work against me.

Enclosed is a Copy of the Unit they was presented. I had thought about it, but it was much bigger, heavier. I was surprised in seeing the price listed. After consideration I asked about enclosed Attachment ~~2~~ 7. They refused as they said rewriting the loan was needed. Their Version, "Resolution," is not how the Lemon Law works.

They then presented A form saying I WAS DENIED. Reason, I live in it "Full time". I had Campsite RV in Cresco, IA. Send A copy of the Bill paid for Storage.

AS "Priced" this unit I then made Effort on the ~~first~~ Second unit. Again, they presented A form Complied with denying, "Credit Card Issue". replace rules.

Interesting. Just A short time Earlier I had been preApproved for over Two Hundred Eighty Thousand Dollars, purchase A Acreage.

("Of course, they refused All Documents.")

The Rep At Campsite Asked me, then later told me to Stop Calling the Colorado office. If not, he would wash his hands of me.

AS of now, Campsite RV, Cresco, IA. is stepping up to EXAMINE And doing the Warranty work, before the Year is up. This Dealer knows I do not "Trust" Cedar Falls. To many others have "told" me what they have Experienced.

Defective?

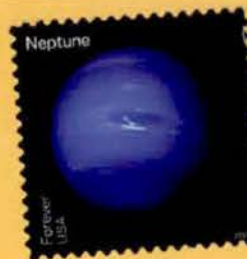


Old, Very Old Bone Handle Forks.
