TL* THE CONTACT OWNS A 2007 CHEVROLET CORVETTE. WHILE DRIVING AT ANY SPEED, THE HIGH BEAM LIGHTS ACTIVATED AUTOMATICALLY WITHOUT WARNING. THE FAILURE RECCURED SEVERAL TIMES. THE VEHICLE WAS NOT DIAGNOSED. THE MANUFACTURER WAS NOT MADE AWARE OF THE FAILURE. THE FAILURE MILEAGE WAS APPROXIMATELY 125,000.

WHEN HEAD LIGHTS ARE ON AT NIGHT AND YOU USE THE TURN SIGNAL THE HIGH BEAMS COME ON AS THE TURN SIGNAL GOES OFF. BY VERY CAREFULLY PULLING TURN SIGNAL LEVER TOWARDS YOU THE HIGH BEAM WILL GO OFF. THAT IS HARD TO DO WHILE DRIVING AT NIGHT IN TRAFFIC. SOME TIMES IT TAKES TWO OR THREE TRIES OVER →

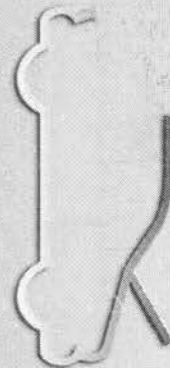
