To Whom It May Concern:

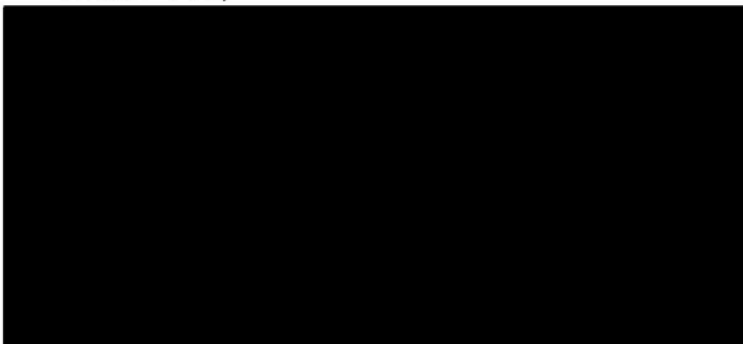
I am the owner of a 2011 Chrysler 200 and received an interim notice from your company a recall for Occupant Restrain Controller.
