I am sending this brief note to see
if you (received) a package with evidence

repurchase / replace my 2014 Santa Fe (Lemon)
and my (only) means of transportation. According
to my tracking this package with 35 page(s) of
fact(s) / evidence should have arrived at your location
on 6/6/2017.

I do (NOT) believe this will be promptly done
because ① My 1st complaint was about the bad/
defective (Emc) Emission (Air Pollution) control
system(s) that I respectfully believe should also
be a (Recall) order problem. Because it was (Noted)
in my 2011-2014 Hyundai Mfg. (Caution(s) Evidence

Cause (a) fire hazards (b) White Exhaust smoke (Air Pollution) (c) Engine damage (d) Loss of power (e) Excessive use/ Loss of oil (f) Carbon Monoxide fumes (g) Poisoning around vehicle, which in my case (made) my 2014 Hyundai unsafe to drive for any (prolong) time or distance. Even without the engine recall from a mfg. foul up even before I bought this (new) lemon with only 56 odometer miles. And as in my case I believe there are possibly thousands of these 2011-2014 Hyundai Santa Fe (gas powered) SUV's that are having these defective (Emc) control system problems. But Hyundai mfg./dealerships are refusing to admit that is the (actual) problem/refusing to honor the warranty, in order to continue to (deceive) both the (EPA) and your office.
