THE CONTACT STATED THAT THE MANUFACTURER EXCEEDED A REASONABLE AMOUNT OF TIME FOR THE RECALL REPAIR. THE HENDRICK TOYOTA DEALER WAS CONTACTED AND CONFIRMED THAT THE PARTS WERE NOT AVAILABLE FOR THE RECALL REMEDY. Concern that the deployment of Takata's recalled airbags are in a vehicle that came from Florida and resides in a state with high humidity. Takata's recalled airbags have been shown to deteriorate in high humidity. No resolution has been offered so this vehicle is not meeting safety regulations and could result in severe injury or even fatalities in an accident that deploys the airbags. Correction of the safety issue needs to be corrected before a failure occurs.
