I recently filed a complaint #1101153 relative to carbon monoxide entering my 2017 Ford Explorer and making me ill. I recently saw on the news that NHTSA was urging Ford to recall the vehicles. Ford has issued a "peace of mind" recall to address consumer concerns.

I am paying to have my Ford independently investigated and to date have found **numerous** leaks in the exhaust system (you have received copies). Under the FOIA law I would like copies of any recent correspondence with Ford relative to the carbon monoxide issue and possible causes, and any related investigative reports you may have done. Any recent information that will allow me to have possible causes independently investigated. Please notify me of any fee's related to this request. Thank you for what you do for consumers and for your help in this matter. I'm a Vietnam combat veteran, [REDACTED] and hoping to live a few more years, not dying from a \$40,000 vehicle.
