Dear Mr. Coleman,

I was originally assured that my Yukon-XL did not contain a Takata air bag. A subsequent recall identified my vehicle as containing the defective air bag and I asked for it to be replaced. The service department representative told me that replacement air bags are not available and I would be contacted when it comes available. I have taken the vehicle back for service and again I am being told that the air bag is not available.

I would like the air bag removed while we wait for a replacement. The idea of an exploding air bag spraying shrapnel in the vehicle cabin is incredibly disturbing. I understand that drivers have been blinded and killed by this shrapnel. Having no air bag is safer than sitting in front of a Claymore mine!

Please contact me at your earliest convenience to schedule removal and then eventual replacement of this airbag.

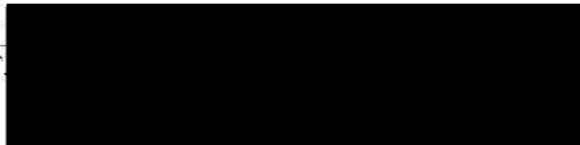
