To Whom It May Concern (Messrs./Misses/Mrs.):

Re: Volkswagen Safety Recall 20A1 - Fuel Filter Flange

Writing to you all hoping you will review VW's inequitable approach to reimbursing customers who already incurred the expense of correcting the problem now identified pursuant to the above referenced safety recall. Supporting documentation is enclosed.

Facts:

- ❖ In February 2017 I incurred \$1,272.37 plus sales tax to address the problem which is the subject of the above referenced safety recall. (\$209.99 for parts, \$22.38 for shop supplies and \$1,040 for labor). Labor was so expensive given the need to dismantle certain components (and replace same) to access the fuel filter flange.
- ❖ The necessary repairs were performed by an independent local mechanic.
- ❖ VW reimbursed only \$484.87 (\$168.75 for parts, \$306 for labor and \$10.12 for taxes).
- ❖ Mailed my claim to VW on 17 March 2018.
- ❖ Followed up with VW 30 March at which time I was told reimbursement had been mailed to me 28 March but VW "could not see in their system how much I was reimbursed". Sounded a bit odd at the time.
- ❖ Following receipt of the grossly inadequate \$484.87 reimbursement amount, spoke with VW again on 10 April. VW informed me that they normally would not even reimburse for labor incurred at an independent mechanic. VW was essentially conveying that I should consider myself fortunate that I received anything for labor. It was clear that the representative, with whom I was engaged, was inexperienced and following a "script" hence I decided my cause would be best served by reaching out to all of you.

I am being penalized because I simply experienced the event and incurred the expense prior to the recall being announced.

How does any of this make sense? More importantly, is this equitable treatment? Is this "best practices" for corporate ethics?

We all know that VW Executives have zero corporate ethics as evidenced by the recent duping of the entire world in connection with the emissions scandal, the associated cover-up attempts and subsequent admission to cheating.

The mere fact that I have had to expend my time to write to you all, due to VW's complete lack of moral conscious and absolute indifference, is infuriating.

This circumstance is yet another example of how poorly VW treats American consumers.

I have decided that, if pursuant to this outreach, I am successful in achieving full reimbursement from VW and you are successful in ensuring VW treats all customers fairly, I will donate the full amount of the reimbursement 1/3rd to each of the following organizations: East Cooper Habitat for Humanity, East Cooper Community Outreach and the South Carolina DNR. I will evidence this donation by reaching out to the Mayor of Mount Pleasant (or anyone else who would likely be prepared to help to validate my pledge).

Perhaps for those consumers who are being equally mistreated, and for those who could really use the money, you all can (a) influence VW's existing questionable practices and (b) going forward, ensure VW implements a behavioral change which culminates in fair treatment for the consumers who unfortunately acquired a VW vehicle.

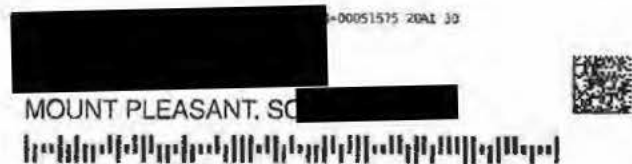

Dear Volkswagen Owner,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Volkswagen has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain 2004-2007 model year Volkswagen Touareg vehicles. Our records show that you are the owner of a vehicle affected by this action.

What is the issue? On certain vehicles, the fuel pump flange may develop fine cracks or fissures, which could result in a fuel leak. Leaking fuel, in the presence of an ignition source, could lead to a fire causing injury and/or damage to property.

What will we do? To correct this defect, your authorized Volkswagen dealer will inspect the fuel filter flange and if cracks, leaks, or yellow discoloration are present, the fuel pump flange will be replaced. This work will take about one hour to complete and will be performed for you free of charge.

What should you do? Please contact your authorized Volkswagen dealer without delay to schedule this recall repair. For your convenience, you can also visit www.vw.com and click on the "Owners" link to locate a dealer near you and schedule this service online.
