I own a 2003 Subaru Outback, which according to numerous announcements from Subaru contains a defective and dangerous air bag on the front passenger side. I understand that the repair is free.

However, I am not going to get it repaired. Here's why:

The local Subaru dealership is located near an intersection with very heavy traffic. I'm over [REDACTED] old and even when younger I found it a little scary maneuvering in that area and getting in and out of the facility. My feeling is that the chances of having a wreck going in for this repair are about 100 times greater than a malfunction of the air bag. Especially in a car that's 15 years old.
