THE CONTACT WAS ABLE TO IMMEDIATELY PLACE THE GEAR INTO PARK DURING THE FAILURE. THE VEHICLE WAS TOWED TO AN UNKNOWN DEALER FOR DIAGNOSTIC TESTING, BUT A FAILURE CODE COULD NOT BE LOCATED.
