This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Takata Corporation ("Takata") has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain GM 2007 model year Chevrolet Silverado LD vehicles. This is based upon Takata's decision that front passenger airbag inflators it supplied to GM are defective. Accordingly, GM will conduct a recall of its airbag inflators covered by Takata's defect information report, unless GM is able to prove to NHTSA's satisfaction that the inflators in its vehicles do not pose an unreasonable risk to safety.

IMPORTANT

- Your vehicle is involved in GM recall 49152.
- The vehicle is presently **safe to drive**.
- There is no need to take action now. You will be notified when parts are available to remedy your vehicle.

Why is your vehicle being recalled?

The propellant in some types of Takata airbag inflators can degrade over time, especially after long term exposure in hot and humid regions. If the propellant degrades to a certain level, the inflators may rupture during deployment, causing serious or fatal injuries.

What will we do?

You will be notified when there are parts available to remedy your vehicle. You can also check the status of this recall at my.gm.com/recalls.

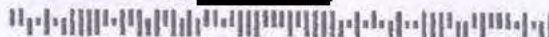
