
Thank you for your correspondence concerning your model year (MY) 2013 BMW R1200GS motorcycle. The Washington Office of the Attorney General forwarded your correspondence to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) and asked that we respond directly to you.

We appreciate the report you provided. Reports from motorists are an important source of information for us. We reviewed our database to identify whether a safety defect trend exists regarding frame problem in MY 2013 BMW R1200GS motorcycles. At this time, there is insufficient evidence to warrant opening a safety defect investigation or to initiate a recall. We entered your information into our database. It will be considered with future reports to identify any safety defect trends that may require our attention. We recommend that you continue to work with BMW and your local dealer to resolve your concerns.

NHTSA is the Federal agency responsible for improving safety on our Nation's highways. We are authorized to order manufacturers to recall and repair vehicles or motor vehicle equipment when our investigations indicate that they contain safety defects in their design, construction, or performance. We also monitor the completion rates and adequacy of manufacturers' recall campaigns.
