Thank you for your "Important Safety Recall" April 2019, Jayco 19V-270, 2019-167, [REDACTED]. The recall has a problem. It calls for taking out a 40 Amperage Fuse and Replacing it with a 25 Amperage Fuse. The conundrum is that they (Buss) do *not* make a 25 Amperage Fuse in that style or size. NAPA, Pep Boys, and O'Reilly's did not have it in stock or could order it. The choices are 20 or 30 Amperage in that size. I chose the 20 Amperage Fuse for my own peace of mind.

Please consider this recall done for my 2015 Jayco, Precept 31 UL, VIN 1F65F5Dy6E0 [REDACTED]

In my 32 Years as a High School Automotive Instructor, I have never seen something like this.
