To Whom it May Concern,

I would like to report a vehicle issue I believe could result in a possible crash and/or cause serious injury or death. I purchased the below listed vehicle on August 12, 2019 and have had repeated brake problems that have not been able to be resolved by the dealer after 5 – 6 attempts at repairing the issue.

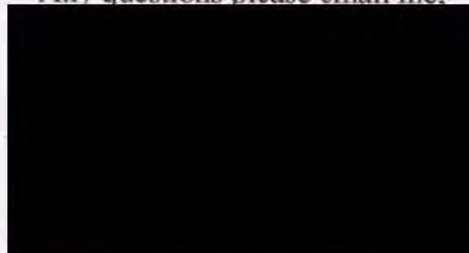
The vehicle is a Kymco Scooter (described below) with a factory installed anti-lock braking system. Upon receipt of the vehicle and during the initial ride home the rear brake locked up. The smell at the time of the incident from the braking system was horrible. Also the ABS warning light came on.

The dealer attempted at least 5 repairs and upon each time the vehicle was returned the ABS Brake Warning light would activate with a few miles after leaving the shop. The problems have ranged from the front brake pulsing during application at speeds under 35 MPH affecting rideability of the scooter. As of the time of this writing the vehicle has only 36 miles on the Odometer and all of these failures have occurred within this short period of riding.
