Thank you for the letter on behalf of your client [REDACTED] concerning his model year (MY) 2018 Ferrari GTC 4 Lusso T vehicle. Your letter was received by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration's (NHTSA) Office of Defects Investigation. I am pleased to respond.

We are aware of the part delay for NHTSA Safety Recall Campaign No. 19V-006 involving passenger-side front air bags manufactured and supplied by Takata Corporation. The recall addresses a problem with air bag inflators assembled as part of the passenger frontal air bag modules, used as original equipment or replacement equipment. In the event of a crash necessitating passenger frontal air bag deployment, these inflators may rupture due to propellant degradation occurring after long-term exposure to absolute humidity and temperature cycling.

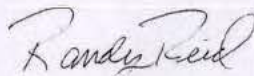
We entered your client's vehicle identification number (VIN) in our VIN Look-Up Tool, and it appears that recall 19V-006 has been remedied. In any event, we understand your client's frustration and appreciate his diligence in this matter. The information provided will be considered with future reports to identify any safety defect trends that may require our attention. An explanation of NHTSA's investigation and recall process is on our website at www.nhtsa.gov/sites/nhtsa.dot.gov/files/documents/mvdefectsandrecalls_808795.pdf. We suggest that your client checks NHTSA's website at least twice per year for new safety recalls by entering his VIN into our Look-Up Tool (<https://www.nhtsa.gov/recalls>).

NHTSA is the federal agency responsible for improving safety on our nation's roadways. We are authorized to order manufacturers to recall and repair vehicles or motor vehicle equipment when our investigations indicate that they contain safety defects in their design, construction, or

performance. We also monitor the completion rate and adequacy of manufacturers' recall campaigns.

If your client encounters a safety-related problem with a motor vehicle or motor vehicle equipment in the future, please have him file a complaint on our website or hotline listed above. Also, owners' complaints, safety recalls, manufacturers' service bulletins, etc. can be reviewed on our website.
