Thank you for the letter about your model year (MY) 2015 Honda Accord vehicle. I am pleased to respond.

The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) is the Federal agency responsible for improving safety on our Nation's highways. We are authorized to order manufacturers to recall and repair vehicles or motor vehicle equipment when our investigations indicate that they contain safety defects in their design, construction, or performance. We also monitor the completion rates and adequacy of manufacturers' recall campaigns.

We appreciate the report you provided. On behalf of NHTSA, please accept our sincere sympathy for the injuries you sustained in a car crash. We reviewed our database to identify whether a safety defect trend exists with the power steering in MY 2015 Honda Accord vehicles that results in a loss of control. At this time, we lack evidence to open a safety defect investigation or to initiate a recall. We entered your information into our database. It will be used with other reports to identify any safety defect trends that may require our attention.
