This rendered my antilock sensor and rear brake pads useless. Later it was determined upon further inspection the bearing failed on the left and right inner axle. The reason for the report, this is a component that has axles with bearings and seals that are pressed on at the factory assembly. All the emergency brake parts and sensors that were damaged.

To make it clear this is a part failure catastrophic in my opinion that public should be made aware safety issue.

THE LOCAL DEALER AND MANUFACTURER WERE NOT CONTACTED. THE VEHICLE WAS TOWED TO AN INDEPENDENT MECHANIC WHO STATED THE REAR AXLE SEALS ON THE END LEAKED DIFFERENTIAL FLUID SATURATED THE BRAKES. THE FAILURE MILEAGE WAS 180,000.
