I am presently the original owner of a 2012 Chrysler Town and Country with VIN#: 2C4RC1BG5C [REDACTED]. I strongly believe that some thoughtful consideration should be given to institute a "Safety Recall" on a particular function of this vehicle.

In question is the starting operation of this vehicle and the possibility of a vehicle engine shut-down while in the driving mode. Following is the part number and description that is malfunctioning from time to time.

Part # 682-448-84AA
Description- TIPM Kit-T 022T1

This part mentioned above is involved with some kind of electric circuit in the large fuse box under the hood. I am sure that you would agree that this could be a dangerous and deadly situation if this vehicle was to suddenly "cut off" the engine while at highway speed.

After doing a little research to this problem, I did find out that the Chrysler Corporation do have "recalls" on some of their other vehicles with the same problem.

I am writing this urgent request hoping that your agency can expedite some kind of "Safety Recall" to prevent some serious accident that might occur with this defect, against an unreasonable risk of a serious accident occurring.

This is such a matter of great importance, that I am really hoping that some kind of a "Safety Recall" can be made.
