Thank you for the letter about your model year (MY) 2020 Nissan Versa vehicle. I am pleased to respond.

The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) is the Federal agency responsible for improving safety on our Nation's highways. We are authorized to order manufacturers to recall and repair vehicles or motor vehicle equipment when our investigations indicate that they contain safety defects in their design, construction, or performance. We also monitor the completion rates and adequacy of manufacturers' recall campaigns.

We appreciate the report you provided. Reports from motorists are a very important source of information for us. We reviewed our database to identify whether a safety defect trend exists with rear brake problems in MY 2020 Nissan Versa vehicles. At this time, NHTSA has not identified sufficient evidence to support the opening of a safety defect investigation or the initiation of a recall. We entered your information into our database. It will be used with other reports to identify any safety defect trends that may require our attention. We recommend that you contact Nissan and continue to work with your local dealer if you need further assistance.

We are aware of NHTSA Safety Recall Campaign No. 20V-112, which addresses a problem with the fuel tank wall having insufficient thickness. This problem may have resulted in a small hole in the seam on the fuel tanks in certain MY 2020 Nissan Versa vehicles. Please note that recalls are very specific in regards to vehicle build dates, affected vehicle identification numbers (VIN), assembly plants, remedy procedures, and defective components. According to Nissan, the affected vehicles were produced between September 06, 2019 and September 23, 2019. Nissan advised that vehicles manufactured prior to and after these dates are not affected. According to the VIN, your Nissan Versa was produced in August of 2019. Therefore, your vehicle is not included in Recall 20V-112.
