To Whom It May Concern:

I have owned three Tesla's. a 2015 Model S, a 2017 Model X and a 2020 Model Y. I was made aware of the above referenced recall by reading news reports, and was certain my 2015 Model S would be covered, given that I paid over \$2,000 to replace the eMMC in June of 2020.

I entered the VIN # (5YJSA1H44F [REDACTED]) on the NHTSA site, and on the Tesla link, and neither indicates that my car is covered.

Yesterday I received a notice that my wife's Model X (VIN # 5YJXCBE48H [REDACTED]) is covered, which prompted me to write this letter to you to see if somehow Tesla neglected to get my Model S included in the recall, especially considering that vehicle actually "experienced" the failure the recall is intended to remedy.
