The contact owns a 2022 Tesla Model Y. The contact stated while driving at 65 MPH with the Self-Driving features activated, the vehicle experienced phantom braking. There were no warning lights illuminated. The contact stated that there were no other vehicles or objects nearby. The contact depressed the accelerator pedal and the vehicle increased in speed and the contact continued to drive the vehicle. The contact stated that the failure had been occurring several times per day while using the Self-Driving feature. The vehicle was not diagnosed or repaired. The manufacturer was not notified of the failure. The failure mileage was approximately 2,000.
