The contact owns a 2016 Hyundai Sonata. The contact stated upon accelerating from a complete stop at a traffic light, the vehicle stalled. The contact attempted to restart the vehicle, but the vehicle failed to restart and emitted an abnormal grinding sound. There was no warning light illuminated. The vehicle was towed to a local dealer, where it was diagnosed that the motor had failed and needed to be replaced. The contact was advised by the dealer that the failure was related to Hyundai Service Campaign Number: 953, regarding the Knock Sensor Detection System (KSDS). The vehicle was not repaired. The manufacturer was notified of the failure. The failure mileage was approximately 93,000.
