I would like to see a defect investigation started for the 2021 Ford Bronco with the 2.7 litre eco boost engine. There has been at least 3 dozen complaints registered on the NHTSA website for complete engine failure. Ford Motor Company is aware of this situation by replacing these engines and other components relating to the failure as well as they have already implemented a change to the affected valves in the engine on newer engines. Ford Motor Company has yet to notify the owners of this vehicle and present a recall. My wife and I are recently retired and purchased this vehicle to travel throughout the US and Canada, but are cancelling these plans as we do not feel safe in this vehicle potentially having the engine self destruct trying to pass vehicles on the highway or turning at a light with oncoming traffic. To my knowledge, no one has yet died from their vehicle stopping on the roadways and would hate to hear this happen. Please look into this issue more, thank you
