The contact owns a 2015 Nissan Rogue. The contact stated while driving approximately 35 MPH, the vehicle made a squeaky and abnormal dragging sound. The contact stated that the AWD light illuminated on the instrument panel. The vehicle was taken to the local dealer and was diagnosed with the rear differential failure. The vehicle was not repaired. The manufacturer was notified of the failure. The approximate failure mileage was 95,000. The issue was ... we changed a rear flat tire with the 'Nissan supplied' spare tire, drove approx 10 mi. to have our tire repaired & returned our tire to the car. After that within 5 days the rear differential had to be replaced. Researching as to why, we discovered no one should replace tire with a different size. Nissan spare is dangerous to use.
