The contact stated while driving approximately 63 MPH, the rear driver's side tire deflated and became completely flat. The contact was able to pull over safely and replace the flat tire with the spare tire himself. The contact stated that the tire was original equipment. The approximate tire and vehicle failure mileage was 3,000. Additional information, right tire spontaneously blew out while parked in my driveway. Unlike the reported tire which was torn to shreds when the blowout occurred on the highway. VIN is invalid.

Traveling w. on I-26 in SC at about 63 mph, Left tire of camper blew out. Moved off highway and changed tire with help from a passer-by. Tire shreds damaged area behind wheel to one structural brace and caused a hole in the flooring.

I firmly believe the tire "blew" out because - after we returned home, the camper trailer was parked and at some time the right tire spontaneously blew out while parked with the trailer jacks lowered, I have that tire and the spare - which is the only intact tire left.
