Assistance Needed:

Our 2018 Chrysler Pacifica (plug-in) Hybrid (our only car) is affected by FCA recall Z11 issued in February 2022 – stating the vehicle is a potential fire hazard “even with the key in the ‘off’ position.” This is related to FCA recall W46, issued in June 2020. Chrysler has said there is no fix available for this problem, and we’ve been instructed not to plug it in, nor to park next to structures or other vehicles. We are incredibly worried about our safety. And, because of this recall, we are also unable to sell or trade in the van. FCA has offered \$1000 - \$2000 trade in incentive on a new Chrysler, but (1) those vans will likely be effected by the same problem and (2) comparable vehicles are nearly \$55,000 (if one can even be located). FCA will reimburse up to \$60/day for a rental but for many reasons we are unable to use/find a rental for this price. We also cannot afford to pay up front – on top of our \$650/month car payment. We’re unable to learn if there *will* be a fix, or when. We don’t feel we can ever be safe in this minivan, and want Chrysler to buy it back.
