Dear U.S. Department of Transportation,

My name is [REDACTED] and I purchased a 2018 Kia Optima from Carvana on May 3, 2021 (VIN# 5XXGT4L3XJ[REDACTED]). I had my car serviced only at Jim Ellis Kia of Kennesaw located at 1221 Auto Park Dr NW, Kennesaw, GA 30144.

My first ever visit to Jim Ellis Kia was on May 11, 2021, because my driver's seat was not adjusting properly when the buttons were pushed. My second visit to Jim Ellis was on January 13, 2022, because I needed an oil change. Problems with this vehicle didn't begin until March of 2022. I reached out to the Jim Ellis Kia of Kennesaw dealership to ask should there be any concern with the oil lamp light flickering on and off. They said yes and gave me an appointment to bring the car in at 7:30am on Wednesday, March 23, 2022. I arrived at Jim Ellis at 7:30am for my scheduled appointment and was checked in by my favorite, most professional service technician ever, Jesus Gutierrez.

While I was waiting in the customer waiting area, Jesus found me and began to explain how my car had no oil in it, and they found no leaks. They decided to run some sort of test on my car after I drove for 1,000 miles. I was instructed to return to the dealership after having driven 1,000 miles and they would then proceed with the test to hopefully determine why my car was losing oil. After leaving the dealership, I texted Jesus to inquire about the burning smell in the car. I was told that oil may have spilled when they were topping the car off with oil and that it should burn off as I continue to drive it.

On Friday, March 25, 2022, Jesus called me to ask how things were going with the fumes in my car. I explained to him that the last time I drove it, the burning smell was still present, and I was having to drive with the windows down. I mentioned having things to do over the weekend and would contact him on Monday, March 28, 2022, and let him know if the burning smell had ceased.

On Sunday, March 27, 2022, I left my home at approximately 8:30am to work as an Instacart Grocery Shopper and an Amazon Flex delivery driver. I typically start up I-75 North near Cartersville, Georgia and work my way back down to where I live in Kennesaw, Georgia. I was delivering a customer's groceries in Taylorsville, Georgia and was getting back in my car to accept a new order and realized that my car was smoking. There was smoke visibly coming inside of the vehicle as I am driving off the customers

property. In my mind, I thought the spilled oil was burning off, no big deal but clearly, it was a huge deal at that point. I told myself to make it home safely and park the car. As I was driving with the windows down, I didn't notice the smoke as much but whenever I brought the car to a complete stop, I would notice the smoke without a doubt.

As I was driving down I-75 South towards Kennesaw, the smoke started getting thicker. I was able to pull off the highway on exit 278 Glade Rd/Acworth. I turned right off the exit and pulled into the Ingles Market located at 5055 Cherokee St, Acworth, GA 30101. I was so scared. I was coughing and struggling to breath. I was able to safely park the car in the Ingles parking lot. As I was getting out the car, I noticed people from the store approaching me with fire extinguishers in their hands. They kept asking me if I was okay. I wasn't okay and was struggling to get to fresh air, I could hear people saying not to try and put the fire out and to call 911. Seconds after walking away from my car, it exploded. I remember hearing a loud bang, glass breaking and fire crackling sounds. Typing this is making me have anxiety. I was so scared! I could have died in that car. Others could have gotten hurt.

I have included documents with this letter along with pictures of my car from the day of the tragedy. I can't comprehend why I am without a car in this moment. I did nothing wrong so why does this lost hurt so much? I know why it hurts like heck, it's because I was out delivering orders trying to make money the best way that I could (accepting that two master's degrees clearly doesn't guarantee me a decent paying job) and my only transportation decides to catch on fire.

This is devastating to me and as a citizen in this country, I need answers from the people up top who make policies because Jesus couldn't help me when I called and told him I survived a car fire. My car insurance company did their job and paid my lien holder. They even had a fire investigator reach out to me for information so he could hopefully determine how the fire started. The problem here is that whatever his results were from the investigation, I will still be without a car. Why is that? Why am I not protected as well? Who looks out for me? The money I received from my insurance company doesn't scratch the surface towards purchasing a new car and I am still concerned about why my car caught on fire in the first place. Is that information going to be shared with me so that I can go after the bad guy and get a new car? Let me guess...I doubt it.

I am currently seeking employment and it's no surprise that I need reliable transportation to get to and from work. I truly need someone to make sense of all of this for me. I am feeling lost, and my mental health is not well considering what I've been through. If someone from your office can assist me with this matter, I would appreciate it. I was happy with my car. Her name was Lexi (short for Alexis). I miss her. I have been through a great deal in my life and honestly after my car caught on fire, I hit rock bottom. Depression has set in heavily and I don't like feeling this way. I am more than my college education. I love life, I love my children, I adore my grandchildren, I love spending time

with my family and friends, and I am the world's best caregiver to my older brother living with schizophrenia, but my life is much harder now that my car is gone.

Please help me understand what happened to my car and why.

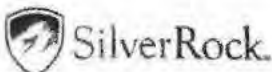

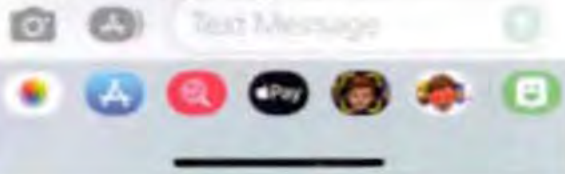
